How Did We Get the Responsibility Statement?

The author of the pledge was the late Al S., a former trustee of the General Service Board, who told the story behind the saying at the sixth International Convention in Denver in 1975. "A statement (on Responsibility) was wanted that would be emotionally gripping to AAs without imposing any musts," he recalled. He tried and discarded several approaches before finally arriving at the thought that it should be (a) personal choice and responsibility - "I" instead of "we."

Ten thousand AAs joined hands at the 1965 30th AA Anniversary Toronto Convention where The Responsibility Declaration was formally introduced by Bill W. It states, "I am Responsible. When anyone, anywhere, reaches out for help, I want the hand of AA always to be there. And for that: I am responsible."

Since it has been distributed throughout the Fellowship and is reprinted in AA pamphlets and Grapevine.
