What Are the Twelve Promises of Alcoholics Anonymous?

In chapter 6 of the Big Book of Alcoholics Anonymous, alcoholics who stay sober and work the Twelve Steps will experience these Promises:

Promise 1: We are going to know a new freedom and a new happiness.

Promise 2: We will not regret the past nor wish to shut the door on it.

Promise 3: We will comprehend the word serenity.

Promise 4: We will know peace.

Promise 5: No matter how far down the scale we have gone, we will see how our experience can benefit others.

Promise 6: The feeling of uselessness and self-pity will disappear.

Promise 7: We will lose interest in selfish things and gain interest in our fellows.

Promise 8: Self-seeking will slip away.

Promise 9: Our whole attitude and outlook upon life will change.

Promise 10: Fear of people and economic insecurity will leave us.

Promise 11: We will intuitively know how to handle situations which used to baffle us.

Promise 12: We will suddenly realize that God is doing for us what we could not do for ourselves.

The Big Book's Promises describe the change in attitude that will transpire within the alcoholic, "sometimes quickly, and sometimes slowly." They may take time, but they "will always materialize if we work for them."

Don't leave before the miracle happens.

TIFFIN On June 5th, 2023, at 7 PM, the Tiffin Group celebrated 17 years of AA meetings. With 65 people in attendance, cake and ice cream were served. A sobriety countdown resulted in an attendee with 53 years of continuous sobriety, presenting a Big Book to an attendee with 4 days. Faraji H. of Iowa City shared his story of recovery.

The 1st Tiffin Group met on June 5th, 2006, with 6 people in attendance at Grace United Methodist Church, 300 W Marengo Rd, Tiffin. They met in a tiny room, within weeks they moved to a larger classroom, and after the meetings resumed following the pandemic, they began meeting in the large open foyer area. There are often 20-25 people in attendance.


UPCOMING EVENTS
