Circle, Triangle, and Alcoholics Anonymous

The triangle inside a circle is a common sight among recovering alcoholics, but what does it symbolize? The circle is representing the Sobriety Circle and Triangle Symbol is used to represent the Alcoholics Anonymous group. The equilateral triangle also represents **unity**, **recovery** and **service** in response to the physical, mental and spiritual parts of the disease of alcoholism. The surrounding circle represents wholeness or oneness and symbolizes serenity and perfection.

The symbol traces its roots to several native cultures, with priests and medicine men regarding the circle enclosing the triangle as a means of warding off evil spirits. AA co-founder Bill Wilson chose the symbol to represent the power of the mind and body in warding off the evil spirits that leads us to addiction.


